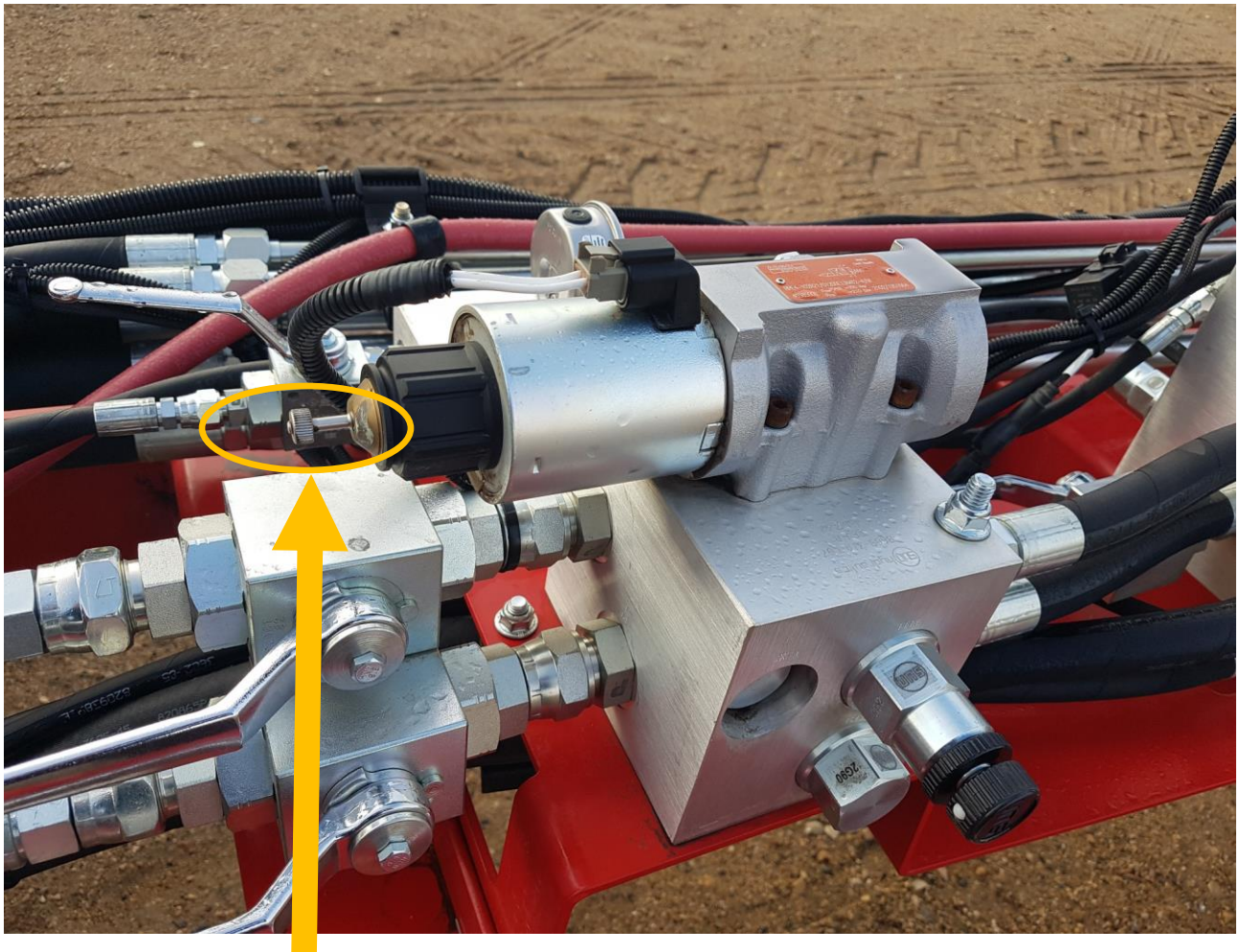

SUBJECT: Hydraulic Changes on Bourgault Independent Opener Drills (3330, 3335, 3820, 3720)

## INFORMATION BULLETIN:

A couple recent changes to the hydraulic circuits on Bourgault independent opener drills has resulted in a very significant operational change.

**On all model year 2022 drills the openers will no longer raise or lower by simply cycling the opener depth control circuit on the tractor. When these machines are NOT connected to a 410 control box or X30/X35 controller the ONLY way to raise or lower the openers will be to use the manual override on the directional control valve.**



Manual Override Screw

A running change will take effect shortly to install an updated tag (part number 3903-98-29) to the directional control valve – which will provide clear instructions.

**IMPORTANT**


This machine is equipped with manual override for the opener depth control. This allows the openers to be raised without the use of the Model 410/415/500 or X35 Controllers. For proper field operation, the manual override must be disengaged to allow openers to be lowered.

**To disengage override, turn hand knob out fully counter clockwise.**

*All model year 2022 drills come standard with wing-lift circuit protection that prevents the raising and lowering of the openers by cycling the opener circuit hydraulics.*

**In order to raise or lower the openers without the installation and use of a controller, this manual screw must be used.**
